FUND OBJECTIVE



The Sub-Fund is actively managed and is not managed in reference to any benchmark.

INVESTOR PROFILE

The portfolio is suitable for investors seeking global exposure to developed financial markets as part of their overall investment strategy, with maximum capital appreciation as their primary goal, and who do not wish to make complex asset allocation decisions between equities, cash and bonds in global markets.
